If this sounds like you, KTC Child and Family Services is looking for a Foster Care Worker. Reporting to the Foster Care Supervisor, the Foster Care Worker is a vital member of the team at KTC Child and Family Services which seeks to provide a safe and healthy environment for children and their families.

Duties/Activities:

- To recruit, screen, train, and support the foster homes for KTC and its communities
- To plan and facilitate the pre-service training for the required level of certification
- To provide liaison between KTC, the communities and other agencies when required
- To work in conjunction with the child and family services workers, community development workers, family support workers and committee members to provide holistic programming for First Nation children and families
- Developing recruitment strategies for establishing foster homes in each community
- Developing and maintaining a foster home roster of available placements
- Ensuring that the security checks and criteria outlined for fostering are met by all foster parents
- Providing the required training and home assessments to all foster families as part of the approval process
- Supporting the foster families on an on-going basis
- Travel may be required, as well as other assigned duties as needed

Qualifications:

- Social Work Diploma/Degree and some related experience or Human Services Diploma with minimum 3 years related experience or certificate with minimum 5 years experience
- Must possess excellent written and oral communication skills
- Must be able to work under minimal supervision
- Train the Trainer and home study certifications required.

Additional Requirements: Current & Valid Alberta driver's license; own vehicle or access to vehicle with \$2M auto liability insurance (when required to use own vehicle); **Please submit Intervention Record Check, Canadian Police Information Centre (CPIC) clearances and a copy of diploma/degree with resume;** submit to Oath of Confidentiality; personal telephone or access to phone; current First Aid Certificate (note: training provided if required); be willing to adhere to agency drug & alcohol policy; ability to speak and/or understand the Cree language is a strong asset. Alcohol and drug testing pre-screening will apply.
