There is no electronic or mail-in voting for this Approval Vote - all votes must be cast in-person. If 50% plus one votes are in favour, the Act will be approved. All electors eighteen years of age and older are eligible to vote.

**COVID-19** protocols will be in effect to comply with Provincial Health Regulations and to ensure that all members can vote safely. If you cannot enter into the buildings for safety or other reasons, then please contact the Approval Officer for designated voting parking outside the building.
