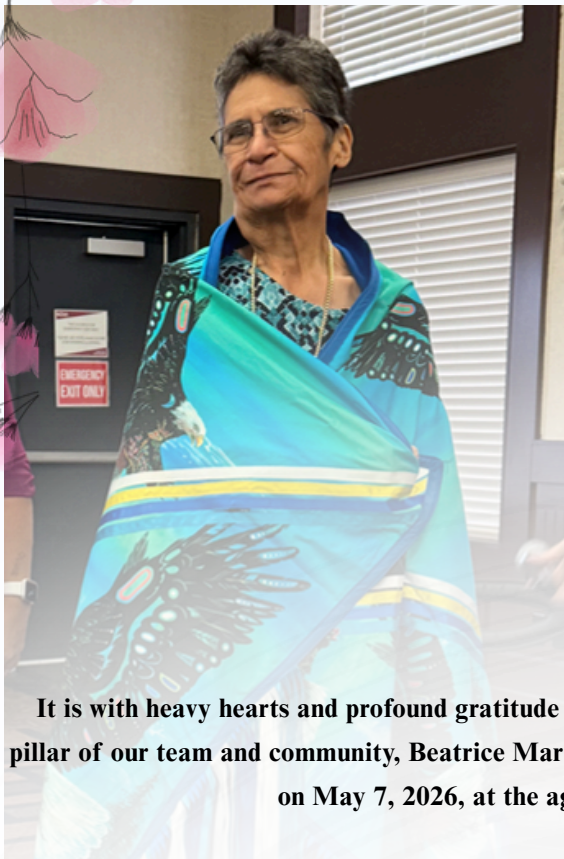


In Loving Memory: Honoring the 30-Year Legacy of Beatrice Mary Tourangeau



It is with heavy hearts and profound gratitude that we say goodbye to a true pillar of our team and community, Beatrice Mary Tourangeau, who passed away on May 7, 2026, at the age of 69.

A longtime resident of Cadotte Lake, Beatrice was raised in the Paddle Prairie Métis Settlement and spent her youth between Paddle Prairie and Carcajou. Her deep roots grounded a lifetime dedicated entirely to lifting others up. Before bringing her talents to Kee Tas Kee Now Tribal Council Child & Family Services (KTC CFS), Beatrice served on the front lines of corrections as a parole officer and addictions counsellor, providing hope and healing to countless individuals.

For the next 30 years, Beatrice committed her career at KTC CFS to the safety, well-being, and unity of children and families. In a field that demands immense emotional resilience. For the past 3 years Beatrice worked as our Elders coordinator. She approached every individual with dignity, seeing the humanity in every situation and guiding families through their most difficult times.

To work alongside Beatrice was to witness true dedication. She was a mentor, a steady presence in times of crisis, and a cherished friend to us all.

While we mourn the loss of an extraordinary woman, we celebrate the powerful legacy she leaves behind—one that lives on in the families she healed and the colleagues she inspired. Our deepest condolences go out to Beatrice's family, friends, and the Cadotte Lake community.

Rest in peace, Beatrice. Your impact will never be forgotten.
